

Zing at Central House - 2020

Central House with about 2,500 sq. ft. A facility that holds group meetings 7 days per week. Due to Covid outbreak facility was closed April and May with meetings resuming in June. When the meetings started again there was a 30 person limit for 3 meeting per day. Starting in September meetings were increased to 6 per day with a 30 person limit per meeting. This calculates to 180 people per day, 7 days = 1260 people per week.

One person, Mark, maintains the building - Dust mopping 7 days per week (Using **Zing Dust Control**), damp mopping 3 times per week (using **ZING KLEEN-UP** 1 oz. per gallon cold water) and burnishing 1 time per week with **Zing KLEEN-UP**.

There is a 'Crown Mat' located outside the building and a large 'New Pig Mat' inside the building. Mark vacuums the outside and inside mats and treats the inside mat with Zing Dust Control 6 days per week, cleaning the inside mat 1 time per week with Zing Entrance Carpet & Mat Cleaner.

All chairs have 'Feet Protectors' to help prevent the chairs from scratching the finish.

May 10th, 2020

Mark stripped the floor to bare tile and applied 4 coats **Zing First Impression Coating**. The next day Mark applied 3 more coats **First Impression Coating** from a gallon that he diluted 50/50 with water.

May 11th, 2020

Floor completely stripped and 4 coats of **Zing First Impressions Coating** was applied on May 10th and 3 coats of **Zing First Impression Coating** diluted 50/50 with water was applied on May 11th. Meetings won't begin until June.








September 17th, 2020

It's been 4 months since floor was stripped and coated with **Zing Fist Impression Coating**. It's been 3 months since the meetings started up again and are now running 6 meetings per day with a limit of 30 people per meeting.









September 17th, 2020

The day we stopped in, Mark was cleaning the 'New Pig' Entrance Mat and treating with Zing Dust Control (See Photos Above)

This was a burnish day for Mark. When he came to an area that showed some scuffing he sprayed Zing KLEEN-UP on the area and worked the high speed burnisher back & forth over the area removing the scuffs. He then continued burnishing.

















November 18th, 2020

Mark decided that he would like to use the **Zing CPC (Cleaning and Polishing Compound)** to burnish his floors. Floors are holding up heat!













December 17th, 2020

During the inspection of the floor I noticed some wear starting to show in the back aisle in front of the chairs. This is a area that is busy. Constant scuffing of feet is starting to show wear in the finish.





First I apply Zing Dust Control to dust mop. Fill empty quart bottle labeled Zing KLEEN-UP 3/4 with cold water. Add 4 oz. KLEEN-UP to bottle.





Dust mop to remove loose dust and dirt. Apply KLEEN-UP to floor and allow to sit 2-3 minutes.

Mark applies UV Marks so that we can monitor the finish wear in the back aisle. I am using UV light to check marks.





Mark pours **Zing First Impression Coating** on floor and applies to area we spray cleaned with **Zing KLEEN-UP**.





Area spray cleaned, marked with UV marker and 1 coat of **Zing First Impression Coating** applied. Now Mark will continue cleaning the floor with **Zing KLEEN-UP** diluted 1 oz. per gallon cold water in a mop bucket.
